Staff are required to undergo an induction training session that informs them on basic access awareness, encouraging the use of the social model of disability.

The Site

Founded in London in 1995, Soho House Group is a private member's club for the creative industries. Cecconi's Dumbo House is a classic Italian restaurant open to the public with waterfront views of Manhattan Skyline. It is located at 55 Water Street, Brooklyn, NY 11201.

The nearest public transport link is via the train on York Street or the cab service directly outside the site. There is no parking at the property.

All entrances, located at the front of the site, are accessible to disabled visitors and are fitted with dropped kerbs and handrails.

All lifts are fitted with alarms and intercom and the site also provides wheelchair platform stairlifts.

At the reception you will find visitor information which is provided in various formats including clear print, large print, telephone and digital. Induction loops and speech enhancement systems are available on request.

Food & Drink

Cecconi's Dumbo House and the outdoor terrace are both accessible spaces and come well-lit with ample seating.

The private dining room is located on the ground floor with restrooms closeby. Lighting in the space can be altered upon request and visitors who are hard of hearing can hire audio equipment.

Textphone facilities, induction loops and deaf alerters can be provided.

Safety

In the event of an emergency, the fire brigade will assist visitors in evacuating the building. More information on the safety and emergency procedures are available in different formats from reception.
