Soho House Global Director of Art

The Soho House Paris art collection includes more than 150 works. Unlike the other Houses, the collection in Paris is strictly painting only and as such is designed to offer a glimpse into the current status of painting in the international art world

Paris is known for its historic painting collections; the Louvre alone holds thousands of canvases, and the Soho House Paris collection responds to this history by providing a selection of works by artists revitalising the medium today, from Oscar Murillo and Flora Yukhnovich to Lynette Yiadom-Boakye and Laure Prouvost.

In the entrance, large commissioned paintings are hung in panels to give the impression that they have always been there, with works by Matthias Garcia, Benoît Maire, Tai-Shan Schierenberg, Clare Woods, Julie Beaufils, Souleimane Barry, Isabelle Cornaro, Florian & Michael Quistrebert and Cecilia Granara.

Despite the curatorial approach, which invited international painters to participate, the House still features more than 65% of artists who were born or based in France

Annie Kevans created a suite of paintings that present historical figures who either privately or publicly moved between conventional modalities of dress for each gender. They include portraits of Frida Kahlo, Andy Warhol, Marcel Duchamp and even Philippe I Duke of Orleans.

As well as a ceiling mural that leads to the cabaret bar, there are murals in 11 of the bedrooms by Paris-based artist Roberto Ruspoli. The other bedrooms all include commissioned artworks by French artists Antoine Langenieux-Villard, Sara J Beazley and Elisabeth Lecourt. The bar features window designs by local artists Natsuko Uchino, Mel O'Callaghan and Fmmanuel Van der Meulen
