The restored Georgian building which plays host to Soho House Toronto has plenty of character - and its expansive art collection is part of the appeal.

In the summer of 2026, following an extensive interior design refurbishment in 2025, the Soho House Toronto art collection was refreshed. This brought in a cohort of 46 new artworks by 21 artists with strong ties to Canada.

Included in the new curation is a photograph by Katherine Takpannie, who refers to herself as an "urban Inuk", currently based in Ottawa. Her family is originally from Nunavut and she continues to connect to her culture through visits to the north and learning from elders. In the photograph "Ookpik", the artist depicts herself with an owl mask, as a symbol of guidance and wisdom safely bringing the spirits of the dead to the afterworld.

Another new addition is the pair of paintings by Jennifer Carvalho, wherein, as a self-proclaimed 'archaeologist of art history', she pulls details from Medieval and Renaissance paintings to place them as the main subjects of her own work.

Four intimate paintings by Keiran Brennan Hinton are wrapped around the central column in the main club, inviting viewers to wander around and get pulled into his tender vignettes which masterfully play with light and atmosphere, teasing scenes that straddle familiarity and the dream-like quality of a memory.

The original collection was curated by Francesca Gavin in 2012, and much of the Canadian talent remains, including artists such as Paul P, Sara Cwynar, Shannon Bool, Sadko Hadziha and Marc Bell. Much of these first-wave artworks can be found in the salon wall on the Third Floor landing.
